

MAIN STREET, PORT AUTHORITY PARTNER TO SUPPORT FESTIVAL

Main Street Wilmington recently partnered with the Clinton County Port Authority to secure a \$5,000 sponsorship investment, designed to benefit the ongoing work and mission of the Main Street Wilmington organization.

"We are really grateful for this show of faith and support for our work", said Matt Purkey, Main Street Board President. "It's really encouraging to know there is recognition that a lively and growing downtown translates into a more attractive community to work and live."

Main Street is a local not-for-profit whose mission is to promote historic preservation and economic development, with the goal of maintaining a cultural downtown district that attracts entrepreneurs and retains businesses, serving as a vital hub for housing, shopping, dining, and entertainment.

Dan Evers, Clinton County Port Authority Executive Director, stated that a vibrant downtown is a significant benefit in the recruitment of new businesses to Clinton County, as well as the retention of existing employers within the community as a whole.
